

How to get to Göttingen

By train

[Train station Göttingen](#)

Göttingen is quite good to reach via fast trains, e.g. from Berlin Airport (~3-3,5h), Frankfurt/Main Airport (2-2,5h), Hamburg Airport (2-2,5h).

If you depart from a European country near Germany, you can possibly travel solely by train to Göttingen, depending on the connections. Please have a look at your local railway company offers and at the [German railway company website](#) for research.

Please schedule some time for delays if you have connecting trains.

By flight

Depending on the country you are departing from, you either have to fly to one of the big international airports (Frankfurt/Main, Hamburg, Berlin) or also have connections to the smaller international airports near Göttingen (Hannover, Bremen).

From the airport you can then travel by train to Göttingen (see above).
